

## How To Use Spray Paint Safely

### For Artists:

- 1 Wear a mask.**  
I recommend the 3M Painters Project Mask. It is around \$95 from Bunnings.
- 2 Wear gloves.**  
I recommend Cyclone gardening gloves. It will give your hands extra grip and allow them to breath so they don't get all sweaty on a warm day.
- 3 Wear safety glasses.**  
I generally wear these just if I'm inside and there isn't enough air flow.
- 4 Paint outside.**  
Avoid indoor painting where fumes will get trapped.

### Checklist For Teachers:

- Disposable gloves
- Disposable masks
- Safety glasses
- Outside location
- Consider using water based aerosol - Use water based aerosol. They do cost a bit more and they also take longer to dry, but they respond very similarly to usual spray paint. Montana Colors have a great range of water based aerosols.
